Winter Driving Tips

Watch Out for Snowplows: Use caution when operating around snowplows and use extreme caution when passing a snowplow. Watch out for snowplows that are equipped with a “wing” plows, they can extend several feet off of either side of the plow. Snowplows frequently stop and backup, so please give them plenty of room.

Never pass through a snowplows cloud!!!! This cloud is created when snowplows are throwing snow. **Never pass a snowplow on the right!!!!** Keep back at least 200 feet. UDOT snowplows often spread salt or abrasives on the road. Following too closely may result in broken windshields or damage paint.

Wildlife & Livestock: Utah has an open range. Slow down and use extreme caution when passing livestock or wildlife. Always be alert for wildlife in the highways outside Utah cities and towns. Deer, elk, moose, pronghorn, or wild horses, may be on the road at any time, especially in canyons or mountainous areas.

Winterizing Your Car: Make sure your car is in good shape for the upcoming winter months. Have your vehicle checked. Things like good tires, good wiper blades, windshield washer fluid and working lights can help keep you out of an accident.
